#### -New Batch converter

ConvertXtoDVD is happy to announce the birth of a baby brother: the <u>batch converter</u>. The batcher allows you to set large numbers of conversions to work "in batch", i.e. automatically one after the other. This tool was developed by a third party in earlier versions of the software, but for V5, we developed our own.



- You can make your ConvertXtoDVD speak like Vador, the Simpsons or your favorite character! What's up, Doc? Not many people know this, but the voice notifications like "operation complete" that come with ConvertXtoDVD can be customized. You can replace them by any sound file of your own. # - How to set update notifications

To make sure you never miss a new version, or if you don't want to be bothered with pop-ups checking if a new version is available, you can customize the update notifications. In ConvertXtoDVD, go to "Help" "Check for updates" then click on "Change update settings": there you can select the frequency of the warnings: on every use, every week or every month.
